2017 Aviation Days Open House Recap

The 2017 Aviation Days Open House, held every year at the York Airport on Father's Day weekend, was another smashing success. Grey skies and a low ceiling threatened early on the first day, but the cloud cover broke and the skies cleared soon after sunrise. The weather for the rest of the two-day event was beautiful. Those who attended enjoyed rides in C-172's, a Beechcraft Baron, a vintage PT-19 military trainer, and a Robinson R44 Helicopter. The Mid-Atlantic Air Museum provided a North American B-25 Mitchell and Grumman TBM Avenger for static display, courtesy of York Flight Training. Several tenants of the York Airport provided aircraft for static display, ranging from single-engine pistons to a corporate jet. Civil Air Patrol and the United States Army were also in attendance with equipment on display. Several of the original race cars which used to speed down the runway when the York U.S. 30 Drag-o-way was in operation were on display in the hangar. The York Airport also hosted a WWII encampment, with reenactors representing both the Axis and Allies.
