Congratulations to Paul Stavrides of Hartsville, PA, for providing the first correct answer to our October 2016 50/50 Challenge question. The graves of William and Catherine Dotson, who both passed in the late 1800's, remain in their original location, just north of the centerline of runway 10/28 at Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport. When the airport, formally known as Chatham Field, was being developed, the military saw the need to construct an east/west runway for large aircraft. The Dotsons' next of kin were notified, but told the military their loved ones would have wanted to stay on the land they cultivated. The government had no choice but to incorporate the grave markers in the new construction.
