Our sponsor, the York County Planning Commission has officially received award of the grant to resurface the south half of the runway from the Pennsylvania Bureau of Aviation. The State will be funding 75% of the cost and the Airport owners will provide the remaining 25%. There is still a chance the work may be performed this year and we expect the runway to be closed a minimum of five consecutive
