# **Runway Closure at the York Airport (KTHV) beginning Monday, May 13, 2019**

The Runway 17/35 rehabilitation project is gaining momentum and work will commence May 13, 2019. The runway will be resurfaced, grooved and painted. This project will require a **minimum two-week runway closure** for fixed-wing operations. Since the work is weather dependent, there is the possibility the closure could extend beyond two weeks. The result will be a smooth runway surface with great drainage properties and high-visibility reflective markings.

**If you are planning to use your aircraft during the anticipated closure period, it will be necessary to relocate it prior to the May 13<sup>th</sup> start date.**

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. During construction, our maintenance shop will be open and will have the capability to relocate aircraft on the field. The airport will continue to be open for rotary-wing flight operations during construction.

Upon the completion of the runway project, the north apron will be resurfaced. This includes ramp areas north and east of the terminal building. We anticipate a one-week closure in mid to late May to complete resurfacing these areas.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we make these improvements to our facility.
